

Since 2017, the Federal Communications Commission has:



- Established SEVEN robocall dockets
- Created the Reassigned Numbers Database (RND)
- Signed TRACED Act into law
- Mandated STIR/SHAKEN
- Established Robocall Mitigation Database (RMD) framework



Federal and State Enforcers are Moving Rapidly, Effectively, and Cooperatively to Protect the Integrity of Voice Communications





FCC Order Breakdown & Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking



So, What Does it Mean?

- Intermediate providers must authenticate unauthenticated SIP/VoIP calls using STIR/SHAKEN
- All providers must submit a plan to the Commission's RMD to include:
 - · Their role in the call chain,
 - STIR/SHAKEN implementation obligations,
 - Any investigation into suspected unlawful robocalling
- Downstream providers CANNOT accept traffic from providers not listed in the RMD
- Establishing new enforcement frameworks to hold perpetrators accountable
- Requesting comments on eliminating STIR/SHAKEN for providers that cannot obtain a Service Provider Code token and use of 3rd party caller ID authentication solutions
